Interviewer: So, I'm going to ask you a few questions about the Intro Week at Fontys. I believe you've been there.

Interviewee: [SEP] Yeah.

Interviewer: How was your overall experience of the inter week?

Interviewee: I like the Intro Week, but I think it wasn't as fun as what I heard from students from other profiles, like I had a friend from one of the medical profiles – I heard they had like sleeping in tents and stuff. I think the ICT wasn't as fun. But I still enjoyed it, especially the concert at Tilburg. That was quite fun.

Interviewer: Unfortunately to hear. Would you say that you made any friends during the Intro Week?

Interviewee: [1] Uh, yes, I did make some friends. Uh, we spent the week together, we went together on different things, but with time we lost touch.

Interviewer: How would you describe yourself? Was it easier for you or would you describe it difficult to start a conversation? Regarding the intro week?

Interviewee: it's a bit harder to start a conversation. When I go with friends and together, we might connect with people, but I wouldn't alone go to someone and start a conversation most of the time.

Interviewer: Okay, and I understand completely. You mentioned that your expectations were not quite met? Would you say that having a gamified experience of the Intro Week, for example, an app that allows you to get to know the people easier and gives you some sort of challenges and badges as reward, is going to enhance your experience and make it easier for you to approach people or get approached.

Interviewee: So, I didn't have any specific expectations that I wanted to be met, but it would be very interesting to have such an app function whatever, that would make uh easier to connect with people and the challenges would be really interesting.

Interviewer: And one last question. How would you feel about sharing basic personal information like hobbies, interests, nationality? So that people participating in the challenges can see it.

Interviewee: Is it just for a students?

Interviewer: Yeah, it's just for the participants, yeah.

Interviewee: [SEP]Yeah, then no problem, I don't.
